January 2007 - Kristy throws movie to see "An Inconvenient Truth"

February 2007 - Kirsten & Kristy launch CM an official non-profit, wanted positive, fun way for moms to make a difference

June 2007 - Kirsten & Kristy launch CoolMom.org web site

August-September 2007 - new campaign: 3 Friends, 3 Changes with SeattleCAN

October 2007 - Kristy steps down as co-director but continues to provide valuable support

August 2009 - CoolMom granted 501c3 status

October 2009 - CoolMom in D.C., Terri Glaberson heads to D.C. via invite from Climate Solutions to speak to our Legislators

October 2009 - CoolMom and other like minded environmental groups organizes one of the largest 350 events in the world!
